Baseline for Measurement

Ozaukee County has been working on reducing binge drinking rates for the past three years with little success and significant community resistance. A refocused effort in 2015 will increase our success and visibility within the community. We have been working with festival committees since 2011 to implement evidence-based strategies to reduce binge drinking and alcohol access with little to no success. During the summer of 2014 we were approached (versus the coalition approaching) by two separate festival committees asking for assistance in changing their alcohol culture. After three years of educating the community we feel we may have finally been heard.

Context

Describe why this objective was chosen and the expected outcome measure(s).

The Ozaukee County Public Health Department coordinates a community health coalition, INVEST. INVEST has four primary focus areas, one of which is alcohol use in Ozaukee County. Our most recent Community Health Survey Report, which was published in the fall of 2014, shows that 35% of Ozaukee County residents binge drink each month. This is an increase from 29% in 2011. Despite our recent coalition efforts, more work needs to be done.

Currently, we are working with the City of Port Washington and their festival committee to implement wristbands at one large festival during the summer of 2015. We are also partnering with festival committees in two other municipalities in an effort to implement at least one evidence based strategy to reduce access to alcohol at their festivals during the summer of 2015. Ideas under consideration include elimination of pitcher use, reduction in serving hours and potentially wristbands.

In addition, two communities have recently passed social host ordinances and we hope to have at least two additional communities pass similar ordinances in the next year.

Input Activities

Ozaukee County will be focusing our efforts on evidence based and promising practices. Our focus will be on festivals and reducing access to alcohol through wristbands, serving hours and elimination of pitchers. INVEST (community health coalition) will also work with local municipalities on a consistent social host ordinance.
