Context

The Pierce County Community Health Needs Assessment identified physical activity and nutrition as the two top health priorities. The goal to address the nutrition priority in Pierce County's Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) is: By 2017, people in Pierce County will improve nutrition through increased consumption of fruits and vegetables, decreased consumption of sugar-sweetened beverages and other less nutritious foods, and increased breastfeeding. The strategies scheduled to be implemented in 2015 are:

*Strategy 1: Healthy Restaurant Menu Options: By 2017, increase the number of restaurants implementing strategies to support healthy eating to five new locations.

*Strategy 2: Reduce Use of Trans-Fats: A minimum of two restaurants will decrease their use of trans-fats in recipes and/or menu items.

1. Encourage restaurants to identify calorie and nutrient content of menu items and/or to identify healthy choice.
2. Provide technical assistance to restaurants to develop healthy choices for children and adults.
3. Promote initiative through local business partners and local media outreach.

Strategy 2:

National Association for County and City Health Officials

1. Increase restaurant owner/manager's awareness about the use of partially hydrogenated oil in foods and cardiovascular risk of consuming trans-fat. Share CDC trans-fat fact sheet with restaurants via email or in person.
2. Adopt procurement guidelines regarding the sale of foods containing trans-fat (partially hydrogenated oil), customized with local distributor item codes.
3. Advise local restaurants to change their frying and cooking oils to ones that do not contain any partially hydrogenated oil.
