Baseline for Measurement

In 2013, a total of 373 environmental health hazard problems in the three counties were investigated. A total of 1093 contacts were made regarding these environmental health hazards which included indoor and open air quality, housing, solid waste, asbestos, lead and water quality issues. The SCEC has undergone changes to the definition of terms on problems and contacts. This has led to a change in reporting of data that is more accurate than in the past. The program is attempting to standardize response to health hazards and make them similar to other counties.

The breakdowns for each county are as follows:

Adams County: Environmental Health Hazard problems (71); contacts (245)

Juneau County: Environmental Health Hazard problems (84); contacts (233)

Sauk County: Environmental Health Hazard problems (218); contacts (615)

Context

The three county consortium experiences numerous environmental health issues including Public Health Nuisances and Human Health Hazards. Environmental Health staff respond to, investigate and resolve these issues. The prevention dollars for Adams, Juneau and Sauk County have been pooled for many years with Sauk as fiscal agent. The environmental health hazards investigated include indoor and outdoor air quality, asbestos, lead hazards, and water quality. Nuisance complaints include housing, solid waste and animals/rabies.
