Baseline for Measurement

2015 AODA activities are a continuation of 2014 activities. The health department will be able to use the baseline survey conducted in 2014 to analyze the effectiveness of the campaign. The department will also use the report and profile tools developed in 2014 to track public policy changes.

Context

In 2013, the health department participated in a plunge, a day long program which took an in-depth look at alcohol use in the local communities. Highlights from the plunge included; youth discussing when and what they drink, excessive drinking as a social norm, gaps in current policy and enforcement, and the cost of AODA abuse for families. As a result of this plunge, many areas within alcohol use were chosen as focus areas for 2014 Community Health Action Team (CHAT) group activities. The health department is one of the pillar agencies of this group. Prevention education and public policy were two of the areas chosen, and the two areas in which the health department has been leading efforts. 2014 prevention education activities included the development of an awareness campaign (baseline survey completed in 9/14 with implementation occurring in 12/14-4/15, and evaluation survey occurring in 2015). Public policy related activities included the creation of an AODA policy brief; highlighting current gaps and challenges in AODA enforcement and treatment and also a survey of local alcohol policies in and around the Shawano-Menominee areas. Another plunge scheduled for January of 2015 will again focus on AODA with an emphasis on employers, treatment, and mental health.

Input Activities

The health department utilized many evidence based strategies in its 2014 activities and will continue to rely on these in 2015. The Wisconsin State Council on Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse (SCAODA) 2010 ACE report has helped prioritize areas of potential policy change including licensing, excessive and underage drinking, and restrictions at community events. Guidance from SAMSHA will be used in 2015 as the health department and CHAT explores the link between mental health and substance use. Similarly, the health department will continue to use What Works for Health, and other clearinghouses of EBP for strategies to implement as part of the prevention education campaign. DHS, CDC and other sources were used in the development of a discussion guide to compliment the campaign. Specific 2015 activities will be; public policy (develop strategic plan for policy activities, narrow focus on specific policy changes) and prevention education (implement awareness campaign, conduct evaluation survey, collect and analyze results, disseminate with partners).
