**Agreement on Scope of Work for Activities Until August 31, 2016  
with the Kenosha County Health Department**

Following the MDCSCC model, the program will provide financial and staff support to strengthen a coalition and impact the pain management practices in Kenosha County. Kenosha County will begin the path laid out by MDSCC including, assembling a broad partnership, catalyzing and conducting local initiatives, obtaining leadership of top county executives, assisting with the hire of a centralized coordinator to handle meeting logistics, and conduct data analysis. Provider education will focus on such things as hosting a Federal Drug Administration Risk Evaluation and Mitigation Strategies (REMS) workshop on safe opioid prescribing practices as well as grand rounds at hospitals and health systems in Kenosha County.
