BRACE Funding 4/2016 – 9/29/2016

Objectives

1. Goal: By 9/29/16 secure the adoption of 3 strategies by La Crosse County Departments to address preparedness strategies that are a result of climate change emergencies.
 - Presentation to select audience of Department Heads to occur during April 2016.
 - Provide the opportunity for 3 Departments to submit a proposal to access up to \$1000 in continuation funding to adopt a climate change strategy.
 - With 50% progress towards completion of the strategy by 9/29/16, the funding will be transferred to the Department involved.
2. Goal: By 9/29/16 provide the La Crosse County Board an update on the strategies underway and potential impact of the adoption of the climate change strategies on the business of La Crosse County.

Audience

Department Heads affiliated with La Crosse County to include: Solid Waste/Landfill, Facilities, Parks, Sheriff's Department, Highway, Planning and Emergency Dispatch.

Budget

Funding Available: \$3000

Expense:

Stipends of \$1000 each to 3 Departments to adopt an approved climate change strategy in their Department

Timeline:

1. April 26, 2016 – Brief BRACE education presentation and meeting with targeted Department Directors to discuss the BRACE opportunity, impact of climate change on La Crosse County business and opportunity to submit a proposal to fund the Department to adopt a climate change strategy of their selection.
2. June 1, 2016, Department climate change strategy proposals due to Health Department Director.
3. June 30, 2016, Notice to Departments of selected climate change strategies.
4. Sept. 1, 2016, Report of at least 50% progress towards completion of the selected climate change strategy due to Health Department Director.
5. Sept. 25, 2016, Finance paperwork completed and internal transfer of funds to selected Departments upon the receipt of the report of at least 50% completion of their climate change strategy.
