#### Baseline for Measurement

Carbon monoxide poisoning emergency room visits are higher in Marinette County as compared to the state average according to the 2015 Environmental Health Profile. Marinette County has an average of 12.4 ER visits per 100,000 people, compared to the state average of 8.2 ER visits per 100,000 people. Our Child Death Review Team has analyzed 3 separate fire related deaths of children in the past 3 years in outlying rural areas of our county.

Marinette County Public Health and City of Marinette Fire Department have active Child Passenger Safety Technicians on staff and both of these programs are well established in our community. Targeted outreach to socioeconomic challenged families is done on a regular basis using HeadStart, WIC and self referrals to the program.

Tourism is a major revenue generator for Marinette County and water/recreational safety is one of the priorities selected by our Safe Kids Coalition.

Marinette County Public Health is the lead agency for Safe Kids Marinette County. We have strong collaboration from local child safety advocates (outpatient therapy, sports medicine, fire, police, schools and YMCA staff are involved). Current Safe Kids activities involve a quarterly newsletter that is shared with other interested agencies helping to promote timely safety messaging, a child passenger safety program at City of Marinette Fire Department and outlying areas of the county during WIC pickup (Crivitz/Niagara), Safe Sleep educational campaign and partnership with the local hospital on Safe Sleep education with new parents, annual Walk to School Day with Garfield Elementary (centrally located school with walkable communities in City of
