Objective Statement (Template Objective)

By June 30, 2017, 36% adults aged greater than or equal to 19 years residing in Brown County excluding the City of DePere will have received a dose of 2016-2017 seasonal influenza vaccine.

A Wisconsin Immunization Registry (WIR) generated population-based standard benchmark report documenting the number of adults in Brown County excluding the City of DePere with an age-appropriate indication during the 14-month contract cycle. Reports should be run with a 45 day buffer to ensure that all updated data has been received by the Wisconsin Immunization Registry (WIR). Include a report of the accountability targets and the progress achieved including the activities and interventions conducted; include any barriers that may have been identified. A summary of progress made on the selected objective(s) will be required at project mid-point.

Baseline for Measurement

Brown County Health Department WIR baseline benchmark result: Total clients: 207013; 57370 clients (28%) met all benchmark criteria, 149643 clients did not. Add 8% for a deliverable of 36%.

The 2015 end of year population based standard benchmark report will be used to determine the baseline for the current adult population based objective.

For the baseline the following parameters will be used to run the benchmark report:

Date of birth range:

19-26 years: 1/1/1989-12/31/1996

greater than or equal to 19 years (Tdap): less than or equal to 12/31/1996 (use 1/1/1900-12/31/1996 in benchmark report)

greater than or equal to 19 years (Influenza): less than or equal to 7/1/1996 (use 1/1/1900-6/30/1996 in benchmark report)

greater than or equal to 60 years: less than or equal to 12/31/1955 (use 1/1/1900-12/31/1955 in benchmark report)

greater than or equal to 65 years: less than or equal to 12/31/1950 (use 1/1/1900-12/31/1950 in benchmark report)

Evaluation date: 1/1/2016 (for Tdap, HPV 3, Zoster and Pneumococcal), 6/30/2015 to assess the 2014-2015 influenza season coverage rates.

Run date: 2/15/2016

Context

Adults will be assessed using the benchmark report for having a dose or doses of Seasonal Influenza vaccine. Progress towards reaching 90% will be measured using a WIR benchmark report. Only adults who have moved out of the agency's jurisdiction may be removed from the cohort for analysis. Unless you can prove that an adult has moved out of your jurisdiction, you cannot remove them from your cohort.

Guidelines for determining increase needed for progress toward contract cycle goals:

20%-29% - 8% above baseline

30%-39% - 7% above baseline

40%-49% - 6% above baseline

50%-59% - 5% above baseline

60%-69% - 4% above baseline

70%-79% - 3% above baseline

80%-85% - 2% above baseline

86%-89% - 1% above baseline

greater than or equal to 90% - maintain

Agencies should consult with their Regional Immunization Representative for assistance with determining activities and interventions that will help them achieve the required increase for their population assessment.

Context Continued

Input Activities

The Wisconsin Immunization Program recommends the following activities to help ensure the success of this objective:

Coordination of immunization services with other LHDs and/or tribal health clinics. BCHD will coordinate scheduling of clinics provided, press releases and flyer distribution with City of DePere and Oneida health depts.

Sharing information on the Adult Immunization Standards with local health care providers. BCHD will provide at least two lunch and learn sessions for providers discussing the current state of adult influenza vaccine rates and ideal coverage goal for Brown County, importance of standing orders for adult influenza vaccine and entering vaccine administration into WIR.

Requesting that adult vaccine doses administered are entered into the WIR. Conduct an assessment as to current WIR data entry practices with five local pharmacies, five long-term care facilities, five occupational health services. Teach them how to put in data accurately and in a timely manner. We will assist with continued learning on WIR and introduce them to the TRAIN team.

Reminder and recall interventions. We will promote adult influenza vaccine within our community coalitions, Casa Alba Melanie, during our home visitation with families, WIC clinics, regular immunization clinics at BCHD, reminder calls to promote receiving the influenza vaccine, social media reminders, Community Connections, 211, Meals on Wheels, This is Public Health event sponsored by BCHD in October 2016.

Work with ADRC to educate our older adult population on facts regarding the influenza vaccine and schedules for flu clinics. BCHD will work on updating the data on WIR for Brown County.

Attend an Immunization Program-approved adult immunization conference (using up to \$500 of adult immunization grant funds) and will develop a plan for disseminating information gathered during an educational session with local health care providers.
