By June 30, 2017, 44% of adults aged greater than or equal to 60 years residing in La Crosse County will have received a dose of zoster.

### Baseline for Measurement

The 2015 end of year population based standard benchmark report will be used to determine the baseline for the current adult population based objective.

For the baseline the following parameters will be used to run the benchmark report:

Date of birth range:

19-26 years: 1/1/1989-12/31/1996

greater than or equal to 19 years (Tdap): less than or equal to 12/31/1996 (use 1/1/1900-12/31/1996 in benchmark report)

greater than or equal to 19 years (Influenza): less than or equal to 7/1/1996 (use 1/1/1900-6/30/1996 in benchmark report)

greater than or equal to 60 years: less than or equal to 12/31/1955 (use 1/1/1900-12/31/1955 in benchmark report)

greater than or equal to 65 years: less than or equal to 12/31/1950 (use 1/1/1900-12/31/1950 in benchmark report)

Evaluation date: 1/1/2016 (for Tdap, HPV 3, Zoster and Pneumococcal), 6/30/2015 to assess the 2014-2015 influenza season coverage rates.

Run date: 2/15/2016

Baseline for La Crosse County: 37%

### Context

Adults will be assessed using the benchmark report for having a dose or doses of (insert vaccine name). Progress towards reaching 90% will be measured using a WIR benchmark report. Only adults who have moved out of the agency's jurisdiction may be removed from the cohort for analysis. Unless you can prove that an adult has moved out of your jurisdiction, you cannot remove them from your cohort.

Guidelines for determining increase needed for progress toward contract cycle goals:

20%-29% - 8% above baseline

30%-39% - 7% above baseline

40%-49% - 6% above baseline

50%-59% - 5% above baseline

60%-69% - 4% above baseline

70%-79% - 3% above baseline

80%-85% - 2% above baseline

86%-89% - 1% above baseline

greater than or equal to 90% - maintain

Agencies should consult with their Regional Immunization Representative for assistance with determining activities and interventions that will help them achieve the required increase for their population assessment.

### Context Continued

- 1) One reminder/recall letter will be sent to persons born between 1/1/1950 and 6/30/1957 who have not yet received their Zoster vaccination. This will total approximately 14,000 letters.
- 2) Attend an Immunization Program-approved adult immunization conference and disseminate information learned with local health care providers and Coulee Region Immunization Coalition members through 2017 CRIC meeting presentations and emails as appropriate.
- 3) Share information on Adult Immunization Standards with local health care providers, clinic and public health nurses, and CRIC members at the 2017 CRIC Symposium (to be held in September 2017). This will probably be bigger than just Zoster vaccine as CRIC involves several different counties (which have all picked different adult immunization contract objectives). Will try to focus on Zoster but may expand to focus on the adult platform to be inclusive of all the counties.

### Input Activities

The Wisconsin Immunization Program recommends the following activities to help ensure the success of this objective:

Coordination of immunization services with other LHDs and/or tribal health clinics.

Sharing information on the Adult Immunization Standards with local health care providers (e.g., during educational sessions or coalition symposiums)

Requesting that adult vaccine doses administered are entered into the WIR

Reminder and recall interventions (e.g., letter, phone call, home visit)

Work with local health care providers to establish standing orders for adult immunization

Use the available billing toolkit to implement a system to bill insured clients for immunization services provided

Attend an Immunization Program-approved adult immunization conference (using up to \$500 of adult immunization grant funds) and plan for disseminating information gathered during an educational session with local health care providers (e.g., during educational sessions or coalition symposiums)
