  - 2. The Children's Resource Center will provide information and consultation to providers and community professionals serving children and youth with special health care needs and their families.
  - 3. The Children's Resource Center will conduct trainings in community resources/supports, youth health transition, and medical home concepts for families and community partners.
  - 4. The Children's Resource Center will connect families with other families through referrals to P2P of WI and partnering to host support parent trainings in their region.
  - 5. The Children's Resource Center will collaborate with community partners to support the needs of children and youth with special health care needs in quality improvement programs.
  - 6. The Children's Resource Center will strengthen opportunities for family, youth, and community member engagement.
  - 7. The Children's Resource Center will extend reach to underrepresented communities that are experiencing inequities.
