Pregnancy Management Goals

- Identify and screen all pregnant women as early as possible
- Provide interventions appropriate to potential risks and needs identified
- Early intervention and the provision of coordinated care over a continuum of settings to reduce the incidence of complications, pre-term hospitalizations, and improve birth outcomes
- Enroll members who meet criteria in the Medical Home Pilot



Member Identification

- Provider notification
- Member notification
- New enrollment information
- Claims information (pregnancy related diagnosis)
- Healthy Birth Outcomes report

Member Screening and Referral

- All pregnant women screened for risk factors
 - Phone screening assessment
 - Information from provider
- Members who qualify for Medical Home Pilot are enrolled in program and receive case management services
- All members enrolled in Molina's Motherhood Matters Program
 - Ongoing screening
 - Educational materials

Services Available for Providers

- Notification of pregnancy incentive
- State reimbursement for birth
- Case management services provided by Abri
- Educational programs and resources through Molina Healthcare's disease management programs

Case Management Services

- All MHP members are enrolled in Abri's Case Management program in addition to the Prenatal Care Coordination services received from the provider
- Case management services include:
 - Assessment of medical history, cultural needs, social needs, and behavioral health needs
 - Individualized plan of care to address clinical issues and barriers
 - Regular ongoing contact with a registered nurse case manager
 - Partner with provider to improve birth outcomes
 - Educational materials

Social Worker Services

Evaluation by a social worker for members with:

- Social concerns (food, clothing, housing, finances)
- Domestic violence
- Behavioral health and/or substance use issues
(referred to Beacon Health Strategies)



Ongoing Monitoring and Tracking

- Molina's care management information system, Clinical CareAdvance
- Provider office records and spreadsheet transmission of risk factors, visits and other clinical data
- Delivery and birth information
