

BadgerCare Plus – ACA Related Updates for IMAC

1. Data Match with CMS – DHS is targeting the end of the month to release information related to the 63K BadgerCare Plus members that transitioned to a QHP. We will also be releasing county level QHP enrollment for those that received a tax credit.
2. Federal Marketplace: Resolving Inconsistencies - CMS is working diligently to resolve situations where applications need additional verification. For most consumers, the information and data they submitted were immediately verified by the marketplace. But in some cases, the information the applicant provided didn't match up right away with existing records. The Marketplace has started to mail or email these consumers a notice with a request for additional information.

Additionally, HealthCare.gov has posted a new blog outlining what consumers should know if the Marketplace asks for more information. Assistors can help a consumer review their notices to identify what documents the Marketplace needs. Assistors can also help the consumer upload or mail documents to the Marketplace. 3. Navigator Grants - On June 10, 2014, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) announced a funding opportunity announcement (FOA) for organizations and individuals to operate as Navigators in Federally-facilitated Marketplaces (FFMs) and State Partnership Marketplaces (SPMs). HHS will award up to \$60 million to recipients across all service areas of FFMs. All organizations or individuals wishing to serve as Navigators, including those that were funded for the first open enrollment period, need to apply for Navigator grants for the new cycle. The deadline to apply is July 10, 2014.

The full FOA can be found by going to Grants.gov. A number of pre-application calls will be hosted by the Center for Consumer Information and Insurance Oversight (CCIIO). The schedule of these calls is:
