

Benefit Recovery Investigation Tracking System (BRITS) Preparation Update

In preparation for the implementation of BRITS in November 2016, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services is recommending that the consortia begin cleaning up their old referrals that are outstanding in CARES Mainframe.
