DSNAP Project Overview

- Vision: This project will automate federally required reporting for the disaster supplemental nutrition assistance program (DSNAP).
- Intended Outcome/Goals: Automate FNS report and streamline DSNAP processing
- Background: Previous process was labor intensive and difficult for both DHS and workers
- Other Presentations:
 - January IMAC announcement about listening sessions
 - First listening session is February 21

Impact Analysis

- No policy changes
- No caseload changes until DSNAP processing period
- DHS will distribute a detailed processing guide and ops memo prior to DSNAP processing period
 - Will include DSNAP affidavit and application as attachments; they are currently hidden online
