Overview

- Effective October 29, 2018, workers will be required to read FoodShare households the appropriate sections of the change reporting requirements script during the FoodShare interview
 - Workers will determine the appropriate parts to read based on household type and ABAWD status

What is not changing?


- Change reporting requirements for FoodShare are not changing
- Change reporting requirements for all other programs are not changing

What is changing?

- Workers must read the appropriate sections of the script to households based on the household type and ABAWD status
 - Script should be read during the FoodShare interview while the worker is on the "FoodShare Budget" page
 - This does not replace any other existing scripts or parts of the interview process

Determining Household Type

- Workers should read
 Section I of the script to
 HREG or FEBD
 households with earned income.
- Workers should read
 Section 4 of the script to
 FEBD without earned income.




Determining ABAWD Status



- ABAWD Status can be determined on the "FS Work Registrant/ABAWD Determination Details" page.
- If a household contains any individuals with an "ABAWD" status, workers should reference the "Refer to FSET" page to determine whether to read Section 2 or Section 3 of the script.

Determining ABAWD Status (continued)



- Workers should read
 Section 2 to ABAWDs
 with a referral type of
 "Time-Limited Benefits"
- Workers should read Section 3 to ABAWDs with a referral type of "Non-Time-Limited Benefits"
