



ebtINSIGHT


Understanding ebtINSIGHT

- ebtINSIGHT is a data warehouse—a central repository of integrated data originating from one or more sources that stores both current and historical data in a single place. It is designed and structured specifically for querying and analysis.
- ebtINSIGHT provides a solution optimized for performance to analyze large data volumes and share or export the results in various formats including Comma Separated Value (CSV in Excel), Portable Document Format (PDF) format, image file, or PowerPoint.
