Approval of November 16, 2023, Meeting Minutes (Katie Sepnieski)

Policy Updates/COVID-19 Policy updates (Department of Health Services)

Healthcare

- Center for Medicaid Services (CMS) has disallowed childless adult premiums and requiring the
 treatment needs question as a condition of eligibility, therefore premiums will not be reinstated.
 This change in policy is permanent and is not just a delay in re-implementation. The Department
 plans to remove the treatment needs question (TNQ) from the application and renewal process
 early in 2024.
- The Department is reinstating premiums for BC+ children effective April 2024 at the member's next renewal.
 - Under state law, the Department is required to charge premiums, but because of federal policy changes, children will not lose coverage for failure to pay.
 - Language will be updated in published materials for members to convey that if a parent is unable to pay a premium for the child, the child will stay covered.
 - An Operations Memo will be published prior to April 2024 that will outline this new policy.
- Based on new federal guidance, the Department plans to reinstate premiums for the Medicaid Purchase Plan (MAPP) members starting in April 2024, and as part of that reinstatement, MAPP members will no longer have a restrictive re-enrollment period for failure to pay a premium.
 - Like CHIP, an Operations Memo will be published prior to April 2024 that will outline the policy change and the plan for reintroducing premiums.
- The Operations Memo on 12-month continuous coverage for children was published on December 4, 2023, and the Department is prepared to move forward with the new continuous coverage policy effective January 1, 2024.

Administrative Memos (Alicia Grulke & Kathy Welke)

- Administrative Memo 23-04, titled Enhanced Federal Funding for Qualifying IM Activities, was published on December 1, 2023.
- Administrative Memo 23-05, titled Estate Recovery Incentive Funds, was published on December 15, 2023.

Regional Enrollment Network (Lorie Graff)

- December 15, 2023 is the deadline for Marketplace coverage to begin January 1st, 2024. Open enrollment is extending to January 16, 2024, as January 15 is a holiday.
- CMS is sharing Open Enrollment data every two weeks. Marketplace enrollments are the highest since 2017.
- Covering Wisconsin shared information on two issues that they've been looking into related to the Marketplace and Income Maintenance Agencies.
 - Duplicate and multiple duplicate applications are being sent from Healthcare.gov (Marketplace) to income maintenance agencies.
 - Issue related to an adult applicant over 100% Federal Poverty Level (FPL) and answers certain disability questions on the Marketplace application and does the involvement of IM impact the Marketplace enrollment.
 - Covering Wisconsin continues to follow up with federal and state partners to explore solutions.
