# Flu Pre-booking

- 2016-17 VFC influenza pre-book
  - January 14 – February 3, 2016
- Can I see what I pre-booked and the status?
- Can I make changes to what I pre-booked?
- Let's take a look!



# Vaccine Ordering

- Review and update inventory site details
  - Is your contact information accurate?
  - Have your delivery days/hours changed?
- Have you accepted all your transfers?
- Are your inventory levels accurate?
- Let's take a look!!



# Vaccine Transfers

- Order fulfillment creates an inbound transfer.
- You **must** accept **all** inbound transfers. It's a time saver and reduces data entry errors.
- Vaccine received, but there is no inbound transfer in WIR, now what?
- Let's take a look!



# Vaccine Returns

- Do **not** transfer the vaccine back to Division of Public Health
- **Do** adjust your inventory under *manage inventory* and specify the reason. This will remove the doses from your inventory.

# Dose Level Eligibility (DLE)

*Dose level eligibility is defined as the ability to record VFC eligibility status at the vaccination level for each individual vaccine administered to a patient.*



# Dose Level Eligibility (DLE)

- Screening clients for their eligibility status.

Eligible for VFC Vaccine			
Medicaid Enrolled	No Health Insurance	American Indian or Alaskan Native	Underinsured served by FQHC, RHC or deputized provider
Not eligible for VFC Vaccine			
Has health insurance that covers vaccines	Other underinsured	Enrolled in CHIP	

- Providers are able to document eligibility at the dose level within WIR.



# Dose Level Eligibility (DLE)

- Dose level eligibility can be submitted via data exchange. (HL7 2.5.1)

# Borrowing Private Vaccine for VFC Eligible Client

- In **rare** instances you may have a VFC eligible client to vaccinate, but you are out of public vaccine. So now what?
