

Federal Funding Examples

- Women Infant Children (WIC) \$98.0 million
- Prevention Block Grant
 - Operations \$1.6 million
 - Aids \$0.8 million (Tribes and LPHAs)
- · Maternal Child Health Block Grant
 - Operations \$4.5 million
 - Aids \$6.5 million (Tribes and LPHAs)

Federal Funding Examples

- Federal Categorical Grants
 - Operations \$25.7 million (State staff & purchases of
 - Aids \$56.4 million (Tribes, LPHAs & some private non-profits)



• Vital Records Fees \$8.8 million

- Radiation Protection \$2.5 million
- Congenital Disorders \$3.7 million
- Gifts and Grants \$21.2 million



- Funding from other State Agencies \$4.2 million
- Tribal Gaming Revenue \$0.3 million



General Purpose Revenue Examples

- State Operations \$4.3 million
- Earmarked for HIV/Aids \$5.9 million
- Workplace Wellness Grants \$3.0 million
- Lead Exposure and Poisoning Aids \$0.9 million
- Dispensaries and Drugs \$0.7 million
- Tobacco Use Control \$5.3 million
- Well Woman \$2.3 million

Community Aids Reporting System (CARS)

- This is the main way we get funding to LPHAs
- Create contract with DPH on Grants and Contracting (GAC) System
- \$1.2 billion of Contract data is entered into CARS annually
- Expenditure reports trigger reimbursements
- Starting in July 2016 prepayments will cease
