

STATE PLAN UNDER TITLE XIX OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT

CATEGORICAL DETERMINATIONS

Categorical determinations that nursing facility (NF) placement is appropriate have been made for the following conditions:

- Convalescent care for acute physical illness which required hospitalization and which does not meet the requirements of an exempt hospital discharge;
- Terminal illness;
- Severe physical illness which would not allow the person to participate in a specialized services plan;
- Provisional admissions pending further diagnosis in the cases of persons with delirium so severe that a diagnosis cannot be made until the delirium clears;
- Provisional admissions pending further assessment for up to 7 days for emergency situations requiring protective placement;
- Respite care for limited time periods;
- Pre-placement stays in a nursing facility not to exceed 30 days; and
- Post hospitalization rehabilitation not to exceed 120 days.

Categorical determinations that specialized services are not needed have not been made by the State.

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
