The State plan for medical assistance is administered by the Department of Health and Social Services, Division of Family Services which agency has approved plans under titles I, IV, X, and XIV.

Civil service rules and regulations as well as classification and compensation plans applicable to Wisconsin State Administration are submitted to the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare on a joint transmittal plan. The State Bureau of Personnel is the official transmittal agent for the state agencies administering grant-in-aid programs, and in this capacity transmits plan material. Wisconsin State Civil Service is administered in accordance with provisions of Chapter 10, Wis. Stats..

Merit system rules and regulations as well as the classification and compensation plans applicable to local administration are submitted as plan material to the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare by the Division of Family Services and is coded as 45 CFR Part 70.
