*WHEREAS*; Wisconsin Children's Mental Health Matters Coalition is effectively raising awareness of the mental health needs of children, youth, and families in our state;


*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim Thursday, May 5, 2016 as

### CHILDREN'S MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS DAY


throughout the state of Wisconsin and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.
