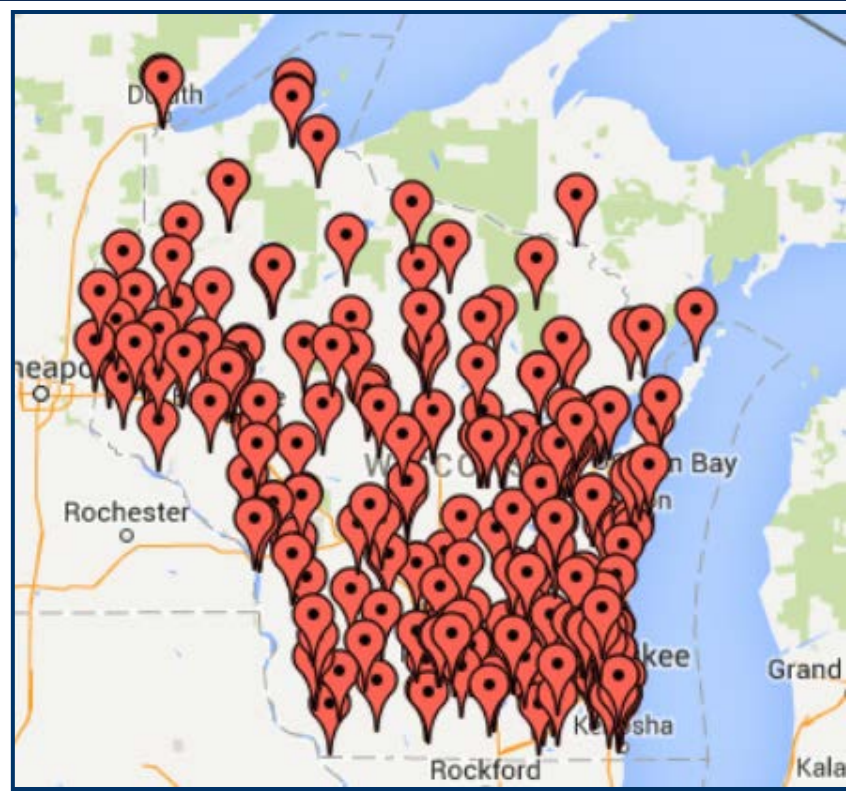


Phase II – UW Eau Claire Evaluation

National Partnership to Improve Dementia Care (Wisconsin ranked 6th)

- In 2012, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) launched the National Partnership to Improve Dementia Care.
- Goal as a nation is to reduce use of antipsychotic medications in nursing homes by the following percentages. Chart shows how Wisconsin compares to the United States:

<u>Goal</u>	<u>Wisconsin</u>	<u>U.S.</u>
- Decrease by 15% end of 2013	14.5	15.1
- Decrease by 20% end of 2014	24.8	20.1
- Decrease by 25% end of 2015	30.1 (Q3)	27.0 (Q3)
- Decrease by 30% end of 2016	TBD	TBD
