
Phase II – UW Eau Claire Evaluation

National Partnership to Improve Dementia Care (Wisconsin ranked 6th)

- In 2012, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) launched the National Partnership to Improve Dementia Care.
- Goal as a nation is to reduce use of antipsychotic mediations in nursing homes by the following percentages. Chart shows how Wisconsin compares to the United States:

| Goal | Wisconsin | <u>U.S.</u> |
|---|-----------|-------------|
| Decrease by 15% end of 2013 | 14.5 | 15.1 |
| - Decrease by 20% end of 2014 | 24.8 | 20.1 |
| Decrease by 25% end of 2015 | 30.1 (Q3) | 27.0 (Q3) |
| - Decrease by 30% end of 2016 | TBD | TBD |
