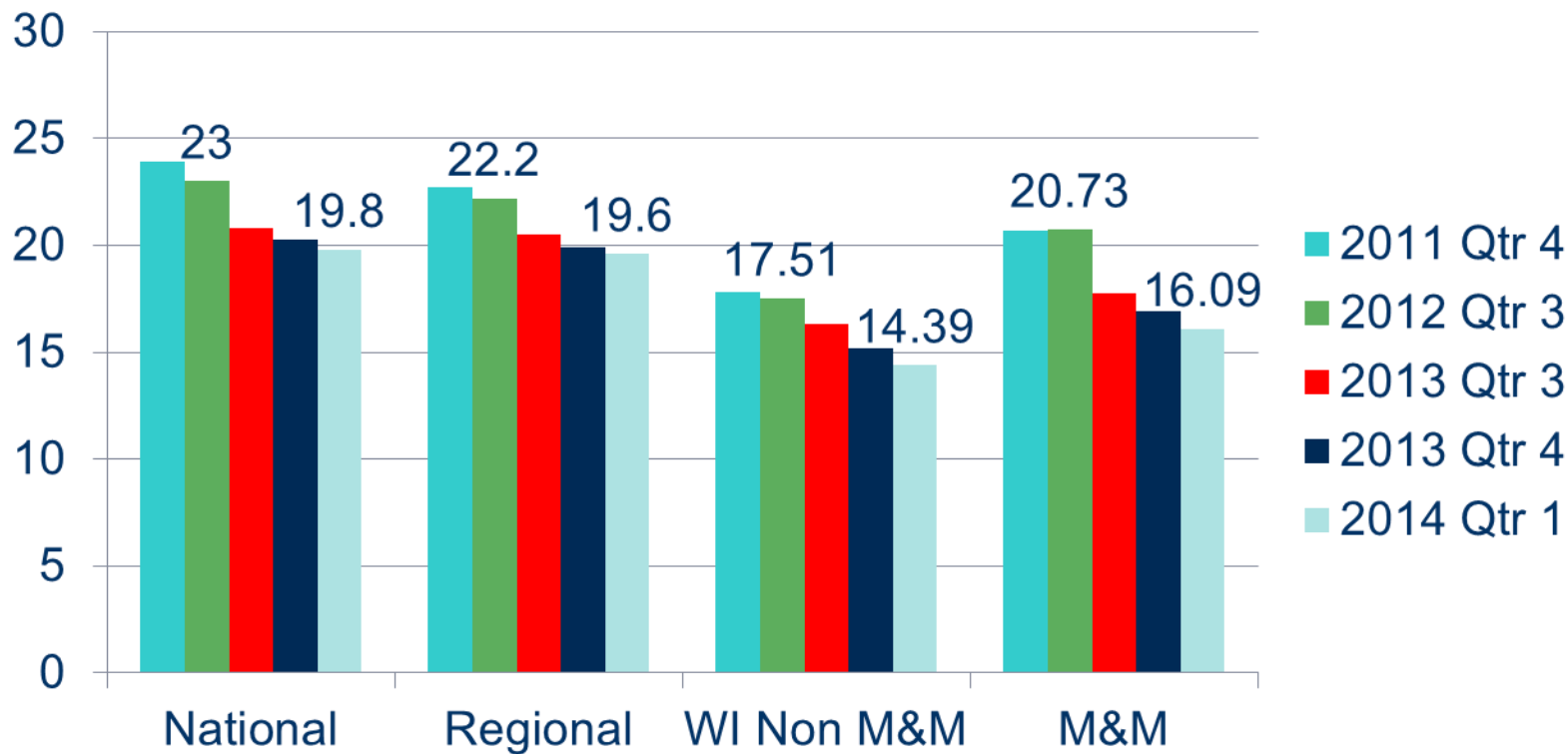

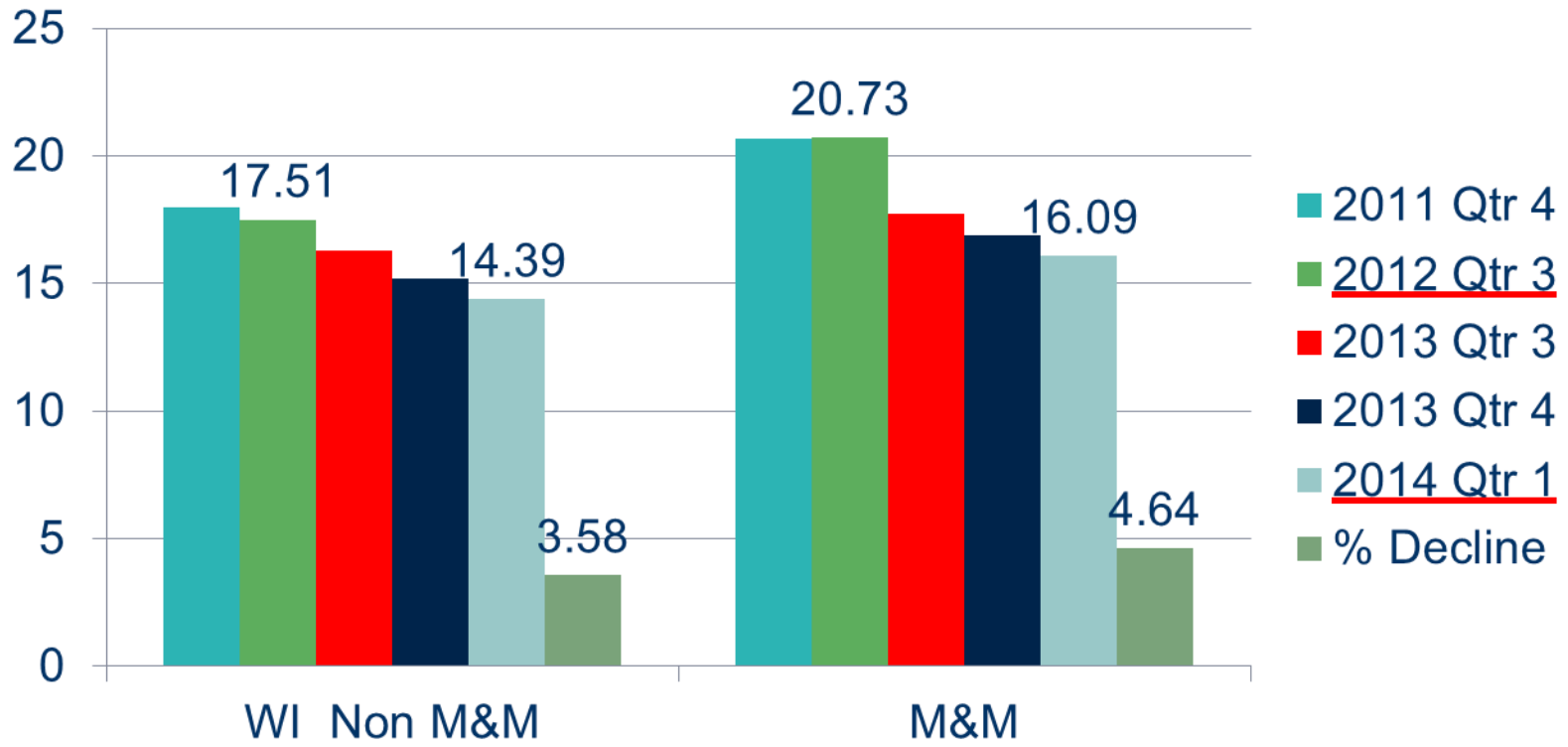

How Are We Doing?





How Are We Doing?

- Percentage Decline 4.64% vs 3.12%
- Rate Decline of 22.4% vs 17.81%



How Are We Doing?

- Assume ALL residents on Seroquel 50 mg (generic) once a day.
- Assume No switching to another product.
- Assume facility rates match only to residents in M&M.
- Assume 1000 residents in sample reflecting M&M.



How Are We Doing?

- Assuming 50 residents are now off of Seroquel and assuming an average retail cost of \$200 per prescription per month. As of Qtr 1 2014 M&M is saving \$10,000 per month in Seroquel costs for drug only. This does not include administration costs, dose reductions and monitoring costs for TD, diabetes, BP etc.

- Music and Memory is working!



What is Working?

- What sparked the reduction in the use of antipsychotic medications?
 - “Treat each resident as an individual”, “look at the person as a whole, not just the behaviors” and “person-centered care.”
 - “Efforts at the state level to improve quality.”
 - “Change in their own administration and key staff prompted a change in practice regarding challenging behaviors.”



What is Working?

- How is process handled for GDR?
 - Pharmacist
 - Psychiatrist
 - Bottom line, there is a lead responsible person.



What is Working?

- Overcoming Change Barrier
 - Test case
 - Setting expectations
 - Letting some people leave
 - Staff team training
 - Staff team communication



What is Working?

- Being Team Investigators
- Being a creative team
- Facility physicians all have same message
- Family Involvement



What Needs Improvement?

- Acute Care
- Family resistance to dose reduction
- Sustainability



What's Next?

- Continue to track
- Expand successes like Music and Memory
- Share resources and allow sharing forums to establish
- Ensure success in Dementia Care Redesign



Focus of Interventions

- Indications
 - Persistent, Harmful, Other Causes Ruled Out
- Start via a telephone order
- Pre-monitor: Trends (Watchful Waiting)



Focus of Interventions

- Drug Review prior to start
- Line List
- Stop Order



Surveyor's Antipsychotic Notes

- Have non pharmacological interventions been attempted?
- Is the behavior
 - Persistent?
 - Harmful?
 - Have other treatable reasons been ruled out?
