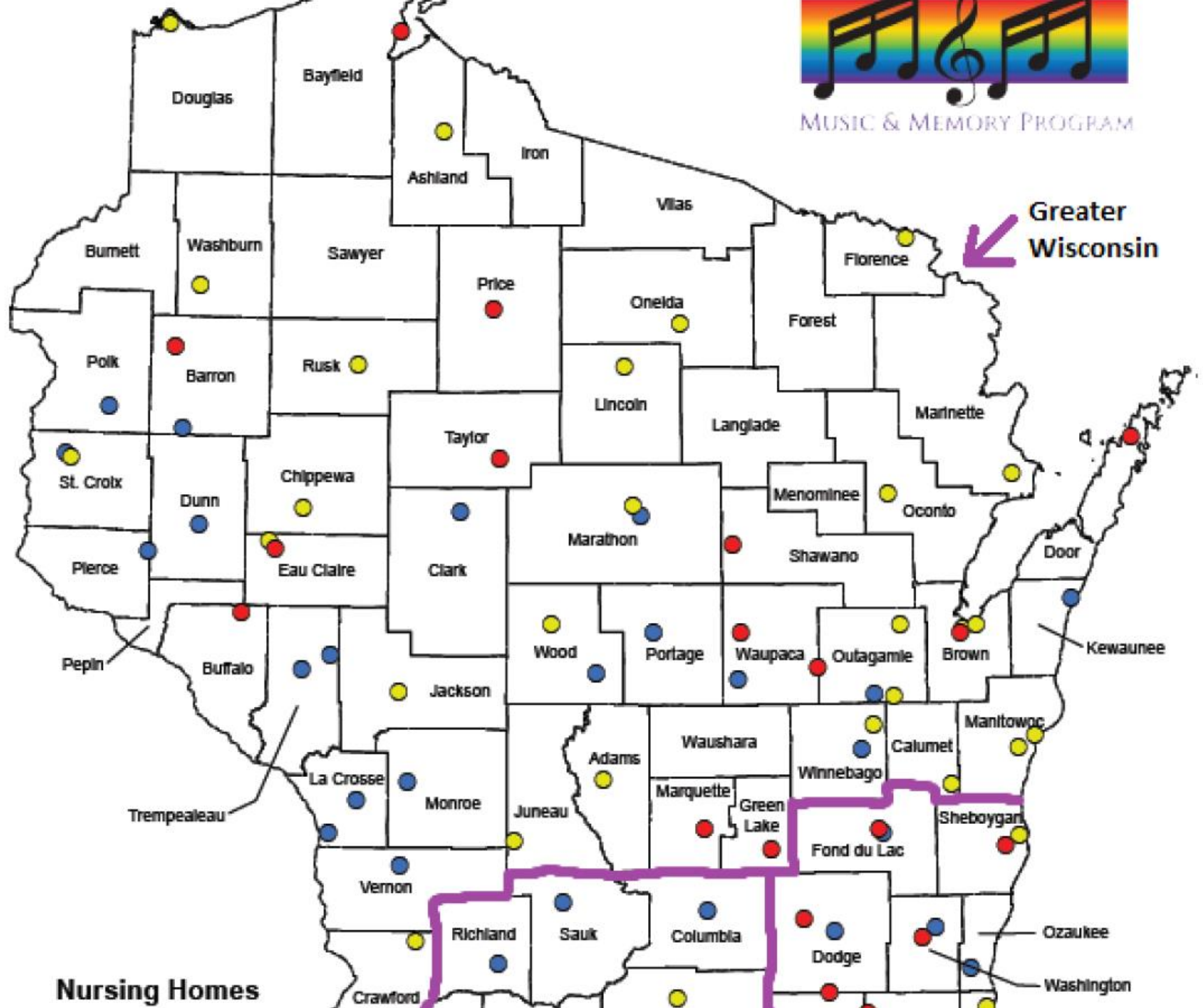
# DHS Partnership with Alzheimer's Associations

# National Partnership to Improve Dementia Care

- In 2012, CMS launched the *National Partnership to Improve Dementia Care*.

● As a nation to reduce use by:	<u>WI</u>	<u>US</u>
– 15% by end of 2013	14.5	15.1
– 20% by end of 2014	24.8	20.1
– 25% by end of 2015	27.0 (Q1)	21.7 (Q1)
– 30% by end of 2016		

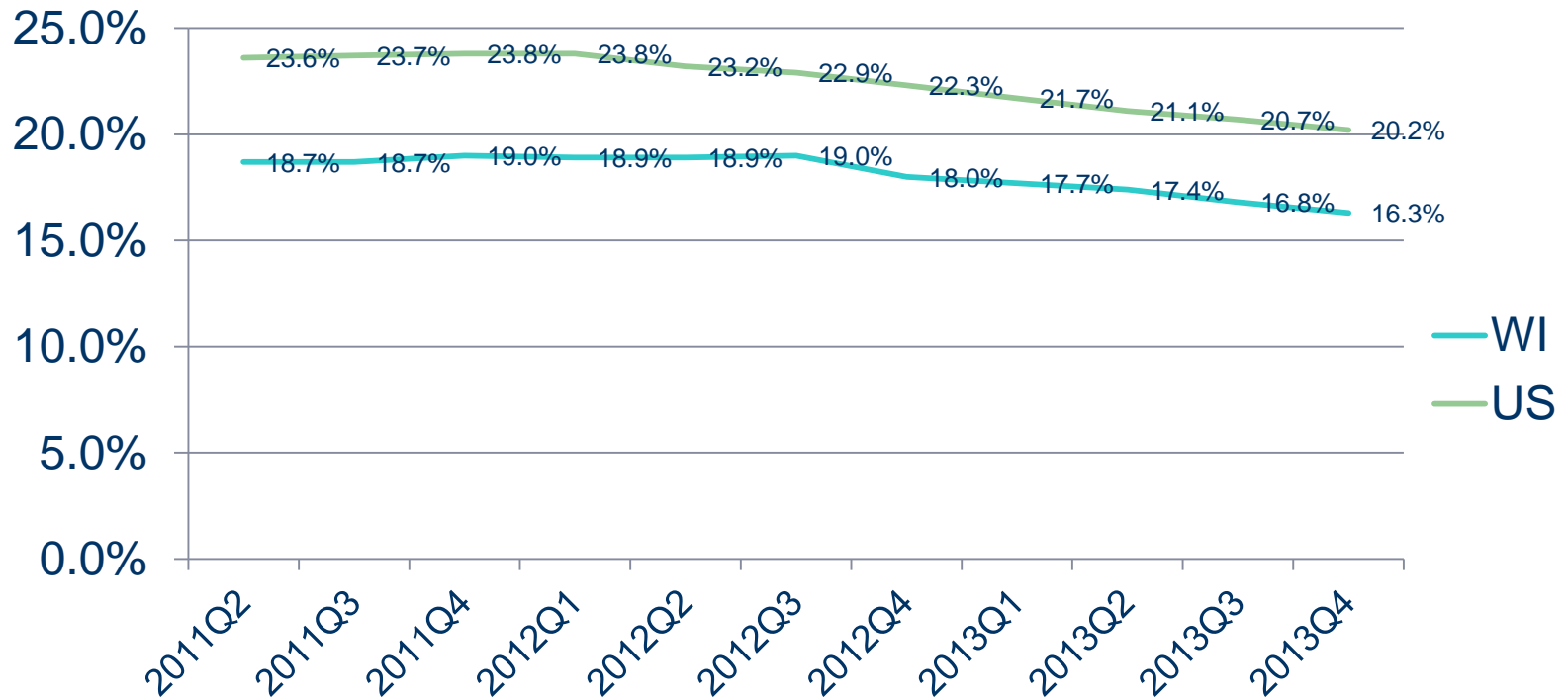

# Percent of Nursing Home Residents Using Anti-Psychotic Medications

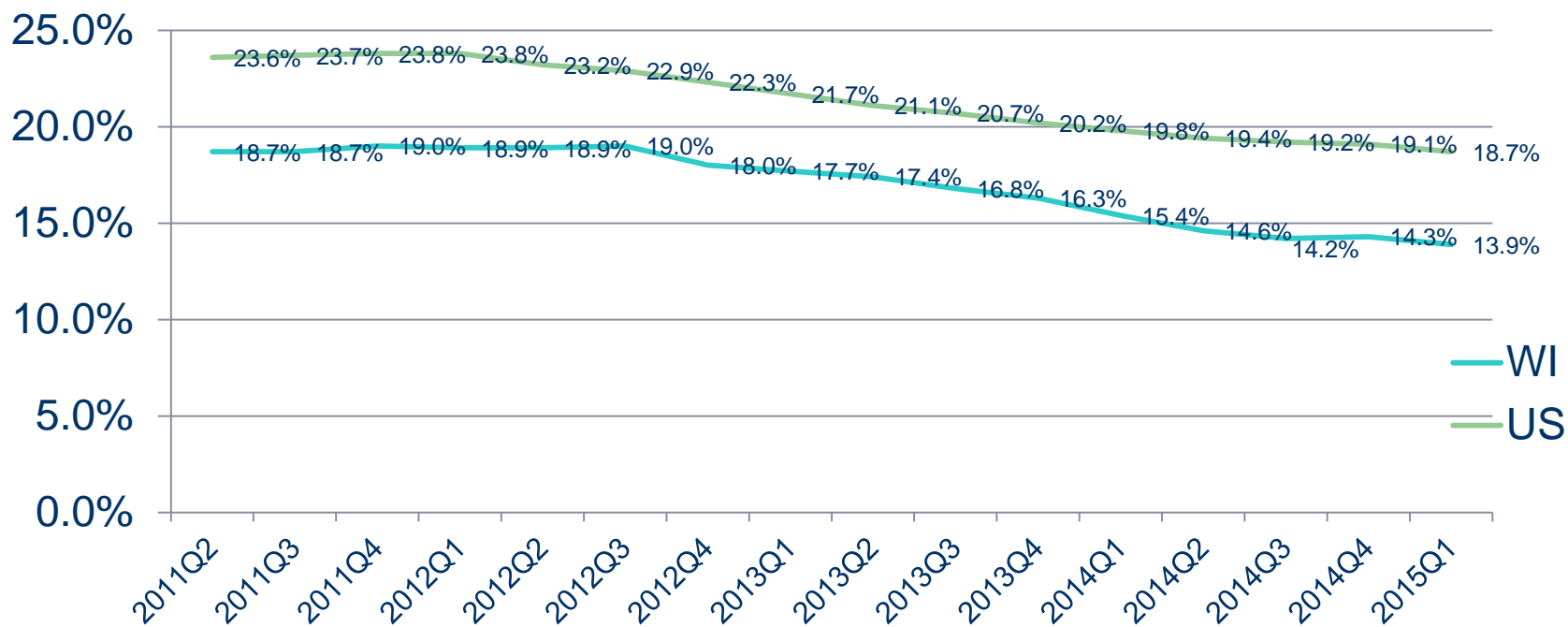
WI Ranking: 10th; 14.5% Decrease (US: 15.1% Decrease)
