Music and the Brain



National Partnership to Improve Dementia Care (Wisconsin Ranks Sixth – 12.8% prevalence)

- In 2012, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) launched the National Partnership to Improve Dementia Care.
- Goal as a nation is to reduce use of antipsychotic medications in nursing homes by the following percentages. Chart shows how Wisconsin compares to the United States:

Goal	Wisconsin	U.S.
– Decrease by 15% end of 2013	14.5	15.1
– Decrease by 20% end of 2014	24.8	20.1
– Decrease by 25% end of 2015	31.6	28.8
– Decrease by 30% end of 2016	32.9 Q1	30.3 Q1
