## Supporting the Right to Vote

- With resident/tenant permission, staff can assist with:
  - Voter registration forms
  - Absentee ballot requests
  - Completion of ballots
  - Sign box for "Certification of voter assistance"

## Supporting the Right to Vote

- Staff can not answer:
  - Questions about the candidates
  - Questions about any political platforms

Must keep votes confidential

## Right to Vote

- Every Citizen age18 or older
- Regardless of where they live

- Can't vote in place of another individual

Rights

Removal of rights by the court

GUARDIAN OF THE PERSON
The individual is in need of a guardian of the person.
A. Rights to be removed in full. If removed, these rights may not be exercised by any person.
The individual has the incapacity to exercise the right to
(1) execute a will.
(2) serve on a jury.
(3) register to vote or to vote in an election.
