

Community Water Fluoridation Equipment Grants

Every year, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) awards grant funding to municipal water systems to help them provide optimal levels of fluoride to their community. Funding is awarded by applying within the appropriate timeframe.

Municipal water systems and representatives of water systems are eligible to apply. Awards vary based on available funds. Funds will not be distributed in advance for project expenses.

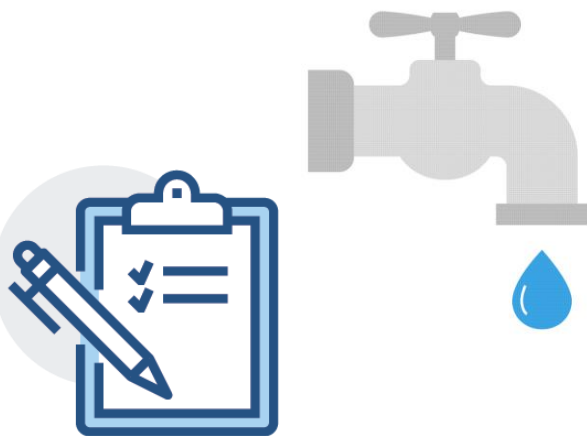
Plan now and be ready to apply when the applications are opened!

Allowable project expenses

- Chemical storage tanks
- Pumps and valves
- Fluoride testing equipment
- Scales and radar sensors
- Personal protective equipment
- Room exhaust and ventilation
- Chemical storage tank ventilation
- Equipment calibration

Unallowable project expenses

- New structures or construction
- Equipment over \$5,000 per piece or unit
- No back-up equipment
- Vehicles
- Installation costs
- General contracting costs
- Engineering costs
