

*WHEREAS*; Medical Reserve Corps members are a vital part of their communities, standing ready 24-hours-a-day to deal with disasters and community events when called upon;


*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim Saturday, May 30, 2015, as

### MEDICAL RESERVE CORPS APPRECIATION DAY


throughout the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.
