WEAVR stands for Wisconsin Emergency Assistance Volunteer Registry. In the event of a natural disaster or statewide emergency, we may call on registry volunteers to supplement local response teams. Your willingness to register with WEAVR helps us create the state's most comprehensive list of volunteers qualified to assist in a large-scale healthcare emergency. A central electronic system to manage volunteers allows for a prompt start to relief efforts. If you're called, we can assign you a relief site as soon as you arrive and sign in.



We're working together for the same goal.

WEAVR is a partnership that integrates local, regional, and statewide volunteer programs such as the Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) and Disaster Medical Assistance Team (DMAT) in assisting during a disaster. WEAVR ensures that the entire state of Wisconsin has coverage when help is needed. Our coordinated activation system draws volunteers from one central database, preventing oversights or misdirected aid, and directing help where help is needed most.

MAKE THE COMMITMENT.

It's fast, easy and online.

Signing up is easy. If you have 15 minutes, access to a computer and the internet, you can complete our online registration. Just have your relevant medical credentials handy for verification by our system. The WEAVR registration questionnaire is simple. Once you complete it, you're immediately placed on the list of qualified volunteers.

Healthcare specialists have busy professional lives, so we strive to make signing up as simple as possible. We know that devoting time to volunteering outside of the "office" means spending even more time away from personal pursuits, so you decide how much time to devote to volunteering. You'll always have the option to decline service if you're called upon. And because the WEAVR system is used primarily during large-scale emergencies, we don't anticipate volunteers being called upon routinely.
