

Enrollment Assistance For The Health Insurance Marketplace And Other Programs For Individuals Living With HIV/AIDS

-- Information For Consumers --

The Wisconsin AIDS/HIV Program in the Wisconsin Department of Health Services receives federal funding from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) to administer two programs for individuals living with HIV/AIDS -- the AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) and the HIV Health Insurance Premium Subsidy Program. These programs help to cover out-of-pocket costs of HIV medications and health insurance premiums for eligible individuals. Both programs will continue to operate after implementation of the Affordable Care Act and may have an impact on the type of coverage you choose to enroll in through the Health Insurance Marketplace. Because of this it is important to work with agencies that have experience enrolling individuals into these programs. The following agencies are able to assist you with enrollment in coverage through the Health Insurance Marketplace and with enrollment in ADAP and the HIV Health Insurance Premium Subsidy Program.
