



APPLICATION COMPLETED THROUGH MARKETPLACE ON OCTOBER 1 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2013


Wisconsin is a Determination State

Marketplace is able to process applications that Wisconsin residents submit to the Marketplace and determine them eligible to be enrolled in BadgerCare Plus. After the member is enrolled, once they report a change or a renewal is completed, an Income Maintenance worker will re-determine their BadgerCare Plus eligibility.




APPLICATION COMPLETED THROUGH MARKETPLACE ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2014


Wisconsin is an Assessment State

Marketplace transfers applications of Wisconsin residents who apply for health care at the Marketplace and appear to be eligible for BadgerCare Plus and Wisconsin Income Maintenance workers process the applications and determine BadgerCare Plus eligibility.
