

Because of the Covid-19 pandemic, STI testing services were running at a minimum level in both STD and non-STD clinics and local health departments. Despite the disruption in STI testing services, Syphilis increased significantly (54%) in 2020, and Gonorrhea cases increased by 2%. The 12.65% decrease in Chlamydia cases could be because of the STI service disruptions.

Technical Notes

1. These reports are compiled by the Wisconsin STI Unit and are based on STI case surveillance data collected by the Wisconsin Division of Public Health (DPH). In Wisconsin, state statutes require both laboratories and health care providers to report cases of chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, chancroid, and pelvic inflammatory disease to local health departments. STI case surveillance data is automatically sent to the Wisconsin STI Unit via WEDSS (Wisconsin Electronic Disease Surveillance System).

2. These reports include cases diagnosed within the specified period. Additional cases diagnosed within the specified period may continue to be reported. Thus, this report should be considered provisional, and it supersedes all previous reports.

3. Reporting of STI cases can be incomplete. Reporting rates can be varied by disease, geographic region, and demographic groups. At any time, reported STI cases represent only part of the total number of diagnosed cases, therefore STI surveillance data likely underestimates total STI morbidity.

4. Rate is calculated based on the population data available on WISH (Wisconsin Interactive Statistics on Health) system website. In these reports, rates presented are cases per 100,000 population (2019). Rates are not calculated for categories with small numbers of cases. See each report for the rate calculation threshold.

5. In these reports, cases are allocated to the derived county at the time of diagnosis. Cases diagnosed among inmates of correctional facilities and cases who resided outside Wisconsin are not included in this report.

6. Congenital Syphilis cases (5) are included in syphilis report.

7. All races are non-Hispanic race. The race Asian includes Asian Pacific Islander. The race American Indian Alaska Native are named Native American as preferred by the tribe.

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
