Intranasal naloxone kit (*ready to use*)

- Naloxone HCL (4 mg/0.1mL)—the pre-packaged kits include two single-use spray devices
- “Opioid Safety and Overdose Prevention” brochure
- Handout on administering naloxone and responding to overdose
- Patient Resource Guide

Intranasal naloxone kit (*assembly required*)

- Two 2 mL Luer-Jet Luer-lock syringes pre-filled with naloxone (1 mg/mL)
- Two mucosal atomization devices—Teleflex MAD 300
- “Opioid Safety and Overdose Prevention” brochure
- Handout on administering naloxone and responding to overdose
- Patient Resource Guide

Auto-injector naloxone kit (*ready to use*)

- Pre-packaged kits containing naloxone HCL (0.4 mg/0.4 mL) and:
 - 2 auto-injectors with audio instructions
 - 1 training device
- “Opioid Safety and Overdose Prevention” brochure
- Handout on administering naloxone and responding to overdose
- Patient Resource Guide

Intramuscular naloxone kit (*assembly required*)

- Naloxone HCL (0.4mg/mL) kit with **one of the following**:
 - One 10 mL multidose fliptop vial
 - Two 1 mL vials
- Two intramuscular syringes, 25 gauge 3cc 1” long
