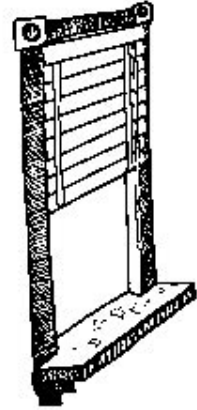


How To Clean Windows and Other Surfaces to Reduce Lead Hazards

What You Need

- A large bucket
- Paper towels
- Plastic garbage bag
- Dish soap that cuts through grease
- Latex or rubber gloves
- A large spoon

How You Get Ready

- Put on gloves.
- Add a large spoonful of dish soap to bucket.
- Fill bucket with warm water.
- Mix well with spoon.

How You Clean

- Wear gloves.
- Remove any toys or other things from windows and throw away or wash them.
- Dip 1 paper towel in the bucket. Squeeze out extra water.
- Wipe surface with paper towel, then throw paper towel in garbage bag.
- Use more paper towels until all dust and paint chips are gone.
- When done, tie garbage bag closed and put out with the trash.
- Pour dirty water down the toilet.
- Wash hands with soap and water.
