





Adding a Trusted Site to Internet Explorer

1. In Internet Explorer (IE), go to fsia.wisconsin.gov.
2. Click "Tools." You can access "Tools" by clicking on the cog under the "X" in the upper right corner or by clicking on "Tools."


If you do not see a "Tools" option at the upper right, look to the upper left, just under the address bar/tab area. If "tools" does not appear, hit the "Alt" key. The toolbar should appear.




3. Select the "Internet Options," "Security" tab and click on **Trusted Sites**, then **Sites**.



4. Make sure "https://*.wisconsin.gov" is present in the trusted sites list.




5. If it is not in the list, you can add it by typing "https://*.wisconsin.gov" into the "Add this website to the zone:" box and clicking **Add**.




Setting Compatibility View

1. In Internet Explorer, go to fsia.wisconsin.gov.
2. Click "Tools." You can access "Tools" by clicking on the cog under the "X" in the upper right corner or by clicking on "Tools."

If you do not see a "Tools" option at the upper right, look to the upper left, just under the address bar/tab area. If "tools" does not appear, hit the "Alt" key. The toolbar should appear.



3. Select Compatibility View Settings from the list.



4. Add Wisconsin.gov to the compatibility view by clicking “Add.” If Wisconsin.gov does not automatically appear in the “Add this website” box, type it in. Then click “Display intranet sites in Compatibility View.” Click “Close.”
