Basic Information

2013 Wisconsin Act 137: Workplace Wellness Grant Program

Legislation enacted in 2014 provides grants to small businesses that create workplace wellness programs after March of 2014. Worksites with wellness programs started prior to March 2014, that previously did not meet the legal definition of a wellness program as outlined by the new law, may still be eligible for this grant opportunity.

Act 137 appropriates \$3 million per year for grants to reimburse workplaces that start new employee wellness programs, as defined by the law. The grant program ends December 31, 2018.

Worksites that meet the criteria receive **reimbursement** for 30% of their wellness expenses (maximum of \$15,000) in a 12-month period. Worksites may submit applications for reimbursement at any time during the year.

Criteria

- Wisconsin worksites with 50 or fewer employees are eligible.
- The worksite must conduct a health risk assessment.
- The worksite must offer at least one of nine health components:
 - ✓ Chronic disease prevention
 - ✓ Weight management
 - ✓ Stress management
 - ✓ Worker injury prevention programs
 - ✓ Health screenings
 - ✓ Nutrition education
 - ✓ Health or fitness incentive programs
 - ✓ Vaccinations
 - ✓ Employee physical examinations
- Up to 12 months of already incurred expenses can be submitted, as this program only reimburses for past expenses.
- Apply by completing the grant application form ([F-01634](#)) and submitting online or by mail.

Program Details

1. Businesses with multiple sites all under one Employer ID Number (example: several sites in Wisconsin, or one Wisconsin site with other sites outside Wisconsin) must collectively total 50 or fewer employees to be eligible.
2. A worksite may only apply for one year of expense reimbursement. Any eligible 12-month period can be chosen, from March 2014 until the grant program end date of December 31, 2018.
3. All expenses to provide a workplace wellness program are reimbursable except any amount paid to acquire, construct, rehabilitate, repair, or remodel real property. The application form includes expense fields for education programs, staff time, health risk assessment, campaigns, equipment, incentives, and contracted services.
