Every fall, in accordance with the Wisconsin Student Immunization Law, schools report the aggregate student compliance with the Wisconsin Student Immunization Law to the public health department

Students are in compliance with the law if they meet the minimum immunization requirements, are in the process of meeting the requirements, or have a signed waiver.

The 'By County' tab contains the results reported from each school for the 2024-2025 school year.

This year, a meningococcal (MenACWY-containing) vaccine was added to the requirements for students entering seventh grade, and a booster dose was required for eligible students entering 12th grade.
