Calendar Year Report on Opioid Treatment Programs in Wisconsin



P-02115-21 (03/2023)

Twenty-two opioid treatment programs provided services in Wisconsin under federal regulations. An opioid treatment program is an accredited treatment program with Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration certification and Drug Enforcement Administration registration to administer and dispense medications that are approved by Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to treat opioid use disorder. Currently, these medications include methadone and buprenorphine products. Other pharmacotherapies, such as naltrexone, may be provided but are not subject to certification and registration regulations. Opioid treatment programs must provide adequate medical, counseling, vocational, educational, and other assessment and treatment services either on-site or by referral to an outside agency or practitioner through a formal agreement.

The use of FDA-approved medications in combination with other supports to provide a whole-patient approach to services for opioid use disorder is known as medication-assisted treatment or medication-assisted recovery.

This report provides one-page summaries for each opioid treatment program. The summaries include the data points required to be reported under Wis. Stat. § 51.4223. All opioid treatment programs also complied with requests to provide additional data.

This report shows patients who were in treatment one or more days of the calendar year. This is not a census report.

Wisconsin opioid treatment programs are required to comply with Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 75.15 regarding the ratio of treatment program staff to the number of patients receiving treatment. If at any time the clinic is out of compliance with this requirement, they are placed on an admissions hold until they come back into compliance with the ratio requirement. Each opioid treatment program has a plan for tapering individuals off methadone. The taper plan varies by individual and is based on their circumstances.
