Calendar Year Report on Opioid Treatment Programs in Wisconsin

Introduction

Opioid treatment programs provide services under 42 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 8. An opioid treatment program is an accredited treatment program with Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration certification and Drug Enforcement Administration registration to administer and dispense medications approved by the Food and Drug Administration to treat opioid use disorder. Currently, these medications include methadone and buprenorphine products. Other pharmacotherapies, such as naltrexone, may be provided but are not subject to accreditation and certification regulations. Opioid treatment programs must provide adequate medical, counseling, vocational, educational, and other assessment, and treatment services either onsite or by referral to an outside agency or practitioner through a formal agreement.

2024 Data Summary

This report provides one-page summaries for each opioid treatment program that operated in Wisconsin during calendar year 2024. The one-page summaries include the data points required to be reported under Wis. Stat. § 51.4223. All opioid treatment programs also complied with requests to provide additional data.

In 2024, the 28 opioid treatment programs in Wisconsin served 12,128 patients, with 12,030 people served at 28 clinic locations and 98 people served at one mobile medication unit.

Of the total patients served in 2024:

- 11,939 were people from one of Wisconsin's 72 counties.
- 47 were people from out of state.
- 1,721 received concurrent behavioral health services.

This report provides data on patients who were in treatment one or more days of calendar year 2024. It is not a census report.
