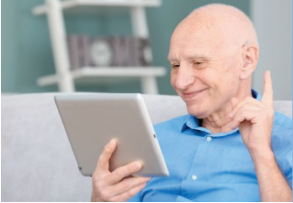


Telecommunication Equipment Authorized for Purchase with Telecommunication Assistance Program (TAP) Voucher



Deaf and Severely Hard of Hearing Telecommunication Equipment

Base Devices

- Amplified telephone
- Non-computer based Teletypewriter (TTY)
- Voice Carry Over (VCO) telephone
- Captioned telephone
- Personal amplification system
- Assisted listening devices
- Bluetooth adapters and hubs
- FM system
- Smartphone
- Tablet

Some restrictions may apply.¹

Note: Refer to Telecommunications Equipment Purchase Program (TEPP) approved equipment list for eligible telecommunication equipment and restrictions if you are also using a TEPP voucher.

Signalers and Other Accessories

- Telephone ring signalers
- Amplified ringer
- Amplified headset
- Bed shaker or bed vibrator
- Battery charger or sleep alert chargers
- Bulb sockets
- Bluetooth streamer device designed for hearing aids or cochlear implants
- Smart device communication apps



Deaf-Blind Telecommunication Equipment

In addition to the items listed above, approved base devices include:

- Deaf-Blind communicator
- PAC Mate with Freedom Scientific TTY
- Braille TTY or refreshable Braille display that can connect with a telephone
