# **Using PRAMS Data to Measure** Social Determinants of Health

### Background

### What is PRAMS?

Pregnancy Risk Assessment Monitoring System PRAMS collects population-based data on maternal attitudes and experiences before, during, and shortly after pregnancy.

### How can you use PRAMS data?

- Access existing data reports. (https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/stats/prams/presentations.htm)
- 2) Request aggregate data.
- 3) Request the research data file.

**Note**—you can request regional data!

#### **The County Health Rankings**

Model provides a framework of social, economic, and environmental factors that contribute to health. Below we use this model to organize some examples of PRAMS social determinants measures.




Education




