School Requirements for Immunization: Sixth-12th grades

Vaccines are required for Wisconsin students.* You can get a copy of the Student Immunization Record from your school or download a copy: https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/forms/f0/f04020I.pdf. At the start of the new school year, give the complete Student Immunization Record to the school.



How do I complete the Student Immunization Record?



Call your doctor or local health department and make a vaccine visit by early summer.



Ask your doctor to **fill out** the Student Immunization Record and then you **sign** it.



Give the Student Immunization Record to the school at the beginning of the new school year.



Call your doctor's office or local health department if you **need help** or more information.
