



# Wisconsin Walgreens Rapid HIV Testing Program

**Total Tests Completed**

In April 2018, the Wisconsin HIV Program launched a new HIV testing program in partnership with Walgreens. Free, one-minute HIV tests are now available at select Walgreens Pharmacies in Milwaukee. There were no positive tests in 2018.

## The Walgreens stores on Capitol Drive and National Avenue performed the most HIV tests.


Number of tests by store




**3 out of every 5 tests were provided to men.**

## Walgreens provided a greater percentage of tests to first-time testers compared to Milwaukee Counseling, Testing, and Referral (CTR) sites.

Percentage of tests provided to people receiving their first HIV test




**74% of tests were done during standard business hours, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.**

Percentage of tests by race and ethnicity




PrEP referrals were offered during 65% of testing sessions.

**16% of those PrEP referrals were accepted.**
