Lead

[Lead-based paint](#) is the primary source of exposure for children. Did you know there are other [emerging sources of lead exposure](#)?

Drinking Water

Many Wisconsinites use private wells for their drinking water. Test regularly for [bacteria](#), [nitrate](#), and [arsenic](#) to ensure safe water at your center.

If you get your water from a public system, you can review your [consumer confidence report](#) to see where your water comes from and what is in it. If you do not find your system on this webpage, contact your local water utility.



Indoor Air

Radon is the number one cause of lung cancer for nonsmokers. Learn more about [radon](#) and what [actions to take](#) to keep your center safe.
