## Prepare for enrolling in your plan

You'll need to answer a few questions about your household to apply for coverage or find out if you're eligible for benefits. The process is quicker and easier when you have this information on hand.

Here's what you'll need:

- Social Security number(s)
- Date(s) of birth
- Home address
- U.S. citizenship or immigration status
- Employment information
- Estimated household income
- Other income and benefits, like child support, Social Security or unemployment
- Housing and utility expenses
- Previous Healthcare.gov account information (for returning consumers)
