Are you or someone you love struggling with alcohol or drug use? Residential treatment may be the next step toward healthier living.

What is residential treatment?

ForwardHealth now covers residential treatment for substance use disorders. In residential treatment, you live at the treatment center and get around-the-clock support and care.

Services include:

- Identifying your unique needs and developing a plan for a healthier life
- Individual, group, and family counseling
- Helping you learn and use recovery skills
- Treatment for mental health concerns
- Identification of other medical needs
- Support for medication-assisted treatment

Alcohol and drug use don't define you. Residential treatment can help you move forward in your recovery journey.

What can residential treatment do for me?

Residential treatment offers a safe place to live and get treatment for your unique needs regarding alcohol and drug use. You will learn skills to become more stable, avoid relapse, and begin rebuilding your life. Residential treatment treats the “whole patient” to support recovery and wellness in all parts of your life.

Who can get residential treatment?

If you are a BadgerCare Plus or Medicaid member, you may be eligible for residential treatment.

You can apply for BadgerCare Plus or Wisconsin Medicaid at www.access.wi.gov.

How much does residential treatment cost?

ForwardHealth may pay for your treatment costs if you are a BadgerCare Plus or Medicaid member. ForwardHealth does not cover room and board, so you may be responsible for those costs. To ask about options for paying for room and board, you can talk to:

- Your residential substance use disorder treatment provider.
- The human services agency in the county where you live.

How can I find a residential treatment facility?

If you're a BadgerCare Plus or Medicaid member, here's how you can find a residential substance use disorder treatment facility with the Find a Provider tool:

1. Go to www.forwardhealth.wi.gov/WIPortal/Subsystem/Public/DirectorySearch.aspx.
2. Click Mental Health under Find Care.
3. Use the Provider Name/Service field. Enter “residential” or a facility name if you are seeking a specific program.

4. Enter either a city or zip code.
5. Select a distance and expand to broader mile ranges as needed.
6. Click Search.
