

# EXTENDED WEAR: Eye Protection, Mask, and Gown Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

## Eyes and Mask

**1**



**Exit patient room and remove gloves.**


See step 3 under *Entry* for gown guidance.

**2**



**Sanitize hands.**

**3**



Only keep eyewear and face protection if they are **not visibly soiled**.


## Gown

**1**



**Get a new gown.**

**2**



**Tear the neck at center.**  
Protect the seams.

**3**



**Tie the gown at the neck and waist.**

## Entry

**Put on fresh gloves.**

**2**



**Sanitize the gloves.\***

If your gown is **not soiled or torn** and you are heading **directly** to another COVID-19 patient, you may keep on.

**4**



**Enter the next COVID-19 patient room.**

\* It is important to always confirm your sanitizer is compatible with your PPE. If you are unsure, test first or consult your PPE specialist. Incompatible sanitizer can compromise the integrity of your PPE.
