



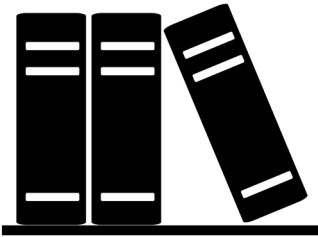
## Wisconsin's School Asthma Program

### PROGRAM IMPROVES ASTHMA CONTROL

- Provides asthma self-management education to students with poorly controlled asthma
- Reduces missed school days, urgent care visits, emergency department visits

- Demonstration project notes: Outcomes were based on average per client analysis. Missed school days and ED visit questions were asked about one year prior to intervention. For comparison to the 3-month post intervention follow-up questions, a 3-month average was used for the pre-intervention data. Demonstrated outcomes were based on 88 students completing the program.
- 68 students completed the Open Airways curriculum and 20 students completed Kickin' Asthma curriculum.



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
